EUROPEAN STUDIES (EURO)

EURO 202 Reading Group in Humanities European Studies (1 Credit)

Selected readings deal with world languages and cultures. Texts read may be classics in a national literature, works by writers who recently won a high literary prize, or texts dealing with current topics critical to the history or politics of a particular country. Texts may be tied to oncampus lectures on world literature by invited speakers. This course can be repeated once for credit with the permission of the chair. Offered for S/U grading only.

Prerequisites: None

EURO 271 Individual Learning Project (1-4 Credits)

Supervised reading or research at the lower-division level. Permission of department chair required. Consult department for applicability towards major requirements. Not available to first-year students.

EURO 302 Reading Group in Humanities European Studies (1 Credit)

Selected readings deal with world languages and cultures. Texts read may be classics in a national literature, works by writers who recently won a high literary prize, or texts dealing with current topics critical to the history or politics of a particular country. EURO 371 Individual Learning Project (1-4 Credits)

Supervised reading or research at the upper-division level. Permission of department chair and completion and/or concurrent registration of 12 credits within the department required. Consult department for applicability towards major requirements. Not available to first-year students.

EURO 372 European Studies Senior Capstone (2 Credits)

All majors must complete a capstone project involving at least two disciplines, to be completed in the senior year and presented in a public forum. Honors 396 and 398 may be applied to the European Studies major, if the topic is appropriate. For further information see HONR 398.

Prerequisites: None

Restrictions: Enrollment limited to students with a class of Senior. Enrollment is limited to students with a major in European Studies.
